Where Do I Start if I Want to Apply?

- Research Portfolio Online Reporting Tools (RePORT) provides access to reports, data, and analyses of NIH research activities: <https://report.nih.gov/>
- RePORTER Matchmaker: <https://reporter.nih.gov/matchmaker>. Enter scientific text like a project abstract and choose:
 - Similar Projects: Use the resulting list of projects to identify which Institute/Center to target or the names of others in the field to connect with
 - Explore what types of projects NIH is funding/has funded in your area of science
 - Identify the appropriate Institute/Center by searching for the Institute/Center that is funding projects like yours
 - Similar Program Officials: Identify Program Officials to contact who are associated with similarly funded projects
 - Provides a graph of relevant Institutes/Centers as well as a table of NIH Program Officials ranked by the number of relevant projects in their portfolios
 - Click the number in the projects column to see the list of awards

Search by keyword or sentence <https://reporter.nih.gov/> or use the Matchmaker interface <https://reporter.nih.gov/matchmaker> (see also above)
 - Find collaborators who are experienced NIH grantees or who have skills that complement your own to improve the strength of your proposal
